

LA County/City COVID-19 Drive-Up Mobile Testing Sites

Am I eligible for testing?

At this time, testing is limited to residents of L.A. County who are experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 or who have been quarantined due to exposure to a confirmed case of COVID-19.

Is there priority for senior citizens or persons at higher risk from developing COVID-19?

Los Angeles County residents who are in the highest-risk categories are eligible for same day or next day testing if they currently have symptoms. This includes those individuals with COVID-19 symptoms who are:

- 65 and older; and/or
- Have underlying health conditions including:
 - Diabetes
 - Heart disease
 - Hypertension
 - Chronic lung disease
 - Moderate to severe asthma; or,
 - People who are immunocompromised, including as a result of cancer treatment
- Los Angeles County residents are also prioritized for testing if they are subject to a mandatory 14 day quarantine period because they have been exposed to an individual with a confirmed case of COVID-19 and have more than 7 days of the 2-week quarantine period remaining.

What should I do if I'm experiencing severe symptoms?

If you or a family member are experiencing severe symptoms, please call your doctor. If you are experiencing a life-threatening emergency, please dial 9-1-1.

Can I just show up at a testing site?

No, tests are by appointment only. Each testing client must give their registration number, which is generated by the screening website
