

Visitation Guidelines

Updated: March 7, 2023

We know how important it is to be able to visit a loved one in the hospital. As a health care organization, the health and safety of our patients, staff and visitors are our top priority.

- If you have cough, cold or any symptoms of flu, COVID-19 or any infectious disease, please do not visit.
- Per California Department of Public Health, visitors to health care facilities are required to wear masks indoors at all times, even when in a patient’s room. Visitors must properly wear a well-fitted disposable mask. This important infection prevention measure protects the health of everyone on our campus.
- Visitors may eat and drink at our on-site Bistro Café or outside in the courtyard.
 - Please refrain from eating in patient rooms, patient care areas and indoor public areas.
 - Exceptions may be made for certain units or at the discretion of nursing leadership.
- Physical distancing is encouraged. Please practice hand hygiene.
- For the safety of patients and staff, please stay in the patient’s room while visiting.
- Huntington Hospital no longer requires proof of vaccination or a negative COVID test to visit loved ones.

Nursing leadership may restrict visitation in certain circumstances.

Adult Inpatient	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Two visitors at a time, 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. • Visitors must be age 12 or older. • One overnight visitor allowed.*
Emergency Department (ED)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One visitor per patient, 24 hours/day. • For minors, two parents (or a support person).
Critical Care Unit (CCU)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Two visitors at a time, 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. • Visitors must be age 16 or older. • One overnight visitor allowed.*
Family Birth Center (Labor and Delivery)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One birth partner and one support person, 24 hours/day. • Visitors must be age 12 or older.
Mother Baby Unit (Maternity)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Two visitors at a time, 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. • Visitors must be age 12 or older. • Siblings of any age may visit. • One overnight visitor allowed.*



Perinatal High-Risk Unit (PHRU)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Two visitors at a time, 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. • One overnight visitor allowed.*
Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Two parents/guardians, 24 hours/day. • Plus, two additional visitors, 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. • Only two at bedside.
Pediatric Inpatient	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Two parents/guardians, 24 hours/day. • Plus, two additional visitors, 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. • Only two at bedside. • Visitors must be age 12 or older. • One overnight visitor allowed.*
Della Martin Center	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Two visitors per patient per day for 30 minutes. • Visits are by appointment <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Monday-Friday: 3 to 4:30 p.m. and 6 to 7 p.m. ○ Saturday and Sunday: 10 to 11:30 a.m. • Please call (626) 397-2323 to make a visiting appointment. • Enter via Pasadena Avenue into the front lobby and ring the bell upon arrival. • Visitation will occur in the day rooms. • No outside items may be brought in.
COVID-19 Positive	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Two visitors at a time allowed for a 2-hour visit between 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. • Visitors must be age 12 or older. • Overnight visitation is not permitted.
End of Life	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We will work with families to ensure that they are able to be with their loved one.
Same-Day Surgery (SDS)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Two visitors total, one at a time.
Outpatient	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One visitor per patient in admit/recovery.

***Overnight stay**

- One visitor per patient.
- Visitor must be age 18 or older.
- Check in via the main lobby by 9:30 p.m.
- No in and out privileges after 10 p.m. Visitors who leave after 10 p.m. may return at 6 a.m.
