We require our teams to be evaluated by Pet Partners, which is a non-profit pet therapy organization.

PAT Team Requirements

- Dog must be one year of age or older.
- Dog must have current required vaccinations.
- Successful completion of Pet Partner registration as part of training program.
- A commitment to at least 8 hours/month of visitation.
- Completion of the hospital's general volunteer orientation and special PAT training sessions.
